



## How Can You Help Grassroots?

People are always asking how they can help Grassroots meet the needs of their Howard County neighbors in crisis. Some individuals and organizations host fundraising events in their neighbor hoods, schools, workplaces and churches and give all or part of the proceeds to Grassroots.

## Are You Looking For A Way To Support Grassroots?

Here are some of the ideas that other individuals, families, businesses and organizations have tried or suggested:

**YARD SALE** Organize a neighborhood sale as a benefit for Grassroots

**BAKE SALE** During the holidays, make seasonal treats and sell them at school, workplace or in the neighborhood and give the proceeds to Grassroots

**CHANGE MATTERS** Join the student campaign to raise funds for Grassroots by collecting change from co-workers on a designated day or week

**DENIM DAY/CASUAL DAY** Designate a specific day as “denim day” or “casual day” and charge employees to participate, giving the proceeds to Grassroots

**SWIMATHON** Host a swim meet and have the swimmers generate contributions for Grassroots by having friends and family pledge a certain sum for every lap completed

**WALKATHON** Host a walk or run and have participants pay to participate and/or generate contributions for Grassroots by having friends and family pledge a certain sum for completing the event

**CUTATHON** Volunteer hair designers give proceeds from their services to Grassroots on a special day designated by a salon hosting the event

**CHURCH COLLECTIONS** Make arrangements for a special collection for the homeless on a designated Sunday and give the proceeds to Grassroots

**ON-LINE CAMPAIGNS** Celebrate your birthday or anniversary or honor the memory of a loved one by notifying your Facebook friends of your campaign to raise funds for Grassroots and direct them to [www.grassrootscrisis.org](http://www.grassrootscrisis.org) to make their contribution

**CONTRIBUTIONS IN HONOR** Make a personal or corporate contribution to Grassroots in honor of your friends and co-workers instead of sending holiday cards or buying gifts

**WINE OR BEER TASTING** Host a social event, like a wine or beer tasting in your home, and ask attendees to make a contribution to Grassroots

**PERCENT OF SALES** Businesses designate a day or week to raise funds and give a percent of sales
